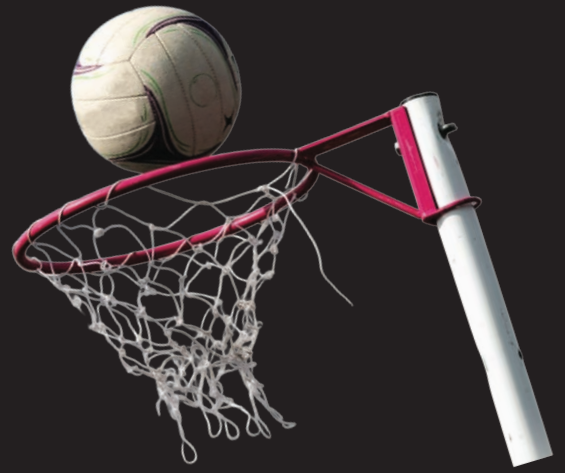

Membership fees are used to purchase new kit (balls, bibs etc) and pay for our coaches who need to have safeguarding, DBS, first aid and undertake coaching qualifications.

CLUB RULES

RESPECT THE GAME

Play not only to win, but to learn, develop and enjoy the game. Always follow the rules of netball and play in the spirit of the game. Treat opponents, officials and spectators with respect at all times.

RESPECT OFFICIALS

Never argue with the umpire or official. Questions or requests for clarification should be raised respectfully through the captain or coach at an appropriate time. Umpires' decision must be accepted.

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR

Abusive, intimidating, discriminatory or offensive behaviour will not be tolerated. Members must demonstrate respect towards teammates, coaches, managers, volunteers, officials and opponents at all times. Bullying, harassment or exclusion of others is unacceptable.

TEAM BEFORE SELF

Team selection, court time and positions are determined by coaches in the best interests of the team development and performance. Selection decision are based on commitment, performance, development and team requirements. Players are expected to support teammates regardless of individual playing opportunities. Bullying, harassment or exclusion of others is unacceptable.

CLUB COMMITMENT

Players selected for Hucclecote Netball Club are expected to represent the club exclusively at club level unless agreed otherwise by the Head Coach and Committee. Attendance at training and matches is expected. Absences should be communicated to the team manager or coach as early possible.

KIT & PRESENTATION

Club kit must be worn at matches, tournaments and when requested at training. Players should arrive appropriately dressed and represent the club professionally. Non-club fashion or franchise apparel should not be worn when representing the club

HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE

Players must warm up appropriately and follow coaching instructions regarding injury prevention. Fingernails must be short, jewellery removed and hair securely tied back before taking to the court. Players must bring sufficient fluids to training and matches. Any injuries, illness or well-being concern must be reported to a coach or team manager immediately.

SPORTSMANSHIP

Show humility in victory and dignity in defeat. At the conclusion of matches, players should acknowledge opponents and officials appropriately, including participating in team thanks or three cheers where customary

SAFEGUARDING

All members must support a safe, inclusive and positive environment. Any safeguarding or welfare concerns should be reported to the Club Safeguarding Officer.



PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

RESPECT

- Treat all players, coaches, officials, volunteers, parents and spectators with respect.
- Value and support teammates regardless of age, ability, background, identity or experience.
- Respect coaching decisions, team selections and positional allocation.
- Accept that court time may vary according to team needs and development objectives.

EXCELLENCE

- Attend training and matches punctually and prepare to give my best.
- Take responsibility for my own development and contribute positively to team success.
- Listen, learn and seek continuous improvement.
- Support and celebrate the achievements of others.

INTEGRITY

- Follow the rules of netball and compete fairly.
- Accept officials' decisions without argument.
- Display good sportsmanship whether winning or losing.
- Act as a positive ambassador for Hucclecote Netball Club at all times.
- Use social media responsibly and never post content that could damage the reputation of the club or individuals connected to it.

INCLUSION

- Help create an environment where everyone feels welcome, safe and valued.
- Never engage in bullying, intimidation, discrimination, harassment or exclusionary behaviour.
- Treat everyone equally regardless of race, ethnicity, nationality, religion, disability, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or socio-economic background.

TRAINING & MATCH EXPECTATIONS

Wear the correct club kit and comply with netball regulations regarding nails, jewellery and hair.

Bring appropriate equipment and sufficient hydration.

Inform coaches or managers of any injury, illness or inability to attend training or matches.

Keep mobile phones away during training and matches unless authorised by a coach or team manager.

Follow safeguarding, welfare and club policies.

48-HOUR RULE

The club operates a 48-hour cooling-off period following matches. Players, parents/carers, coaches and team managers should not initiate discussions regarding team selection, court time, playing positions, tactics or other performance-related matters until 48 hours have elapsed following a match. This helps ensure conversations take place respectfully, constructively and after appropriate reflection. Matters relating to safeguarding, welfare, health and safety remain exempt and should be raised immediately through the appropriate channels.

PARENT/CARER CODE OF CONDUCT

RESPECT

- Encourage my child to play within the rules and respect officials, coaches, teammates and opponents.
- Support coaches, managers and volunteers and respect their decision.
- Demonstrate positive behaviour and language at all times.
- Applaud effort, good play and sportsmanship from all players, regardless of team affiliation.

EXCELLENCE

- Encourage my child to focus on effort, learning, enjoyment and personal development.
- Support my child in attending training, matches and club commitments punctually and prepared.
- Help foster resilience by recognising that success includes both winning and learning from setbacks.

INTEGRITY

- Act as a positive ambassador for the club.
- Raise concerns through the appropriate club channels in a respectful and constructive manner.
- Use social media responsibly and refrain from posting negative, abusive or inappropriate comments about players, coaches, officials, volunteers or the club. Do not post pictures of other children unless permission has been granted.

INCLUSION

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants.
- Promote an environment free from discrimination, harassment, bullying and abuse.
- Support the club's commitment to equality, diversity and inclusion.

SAFEGUARDING & WELFARE

- Familiarise myself with the club's safeguarding and welfare policies.
- Report any safeguarding concerns to the Club Safeguarding Officer.
- Ensure my child's welfare and well-being are prioritised above sporting outcomes.

AS A PARENT/CARER I WILL NOT:

Ask my child or place unreasonable expectations on them.

Criticise, ridicule or verbally abuse players, coaches, officials, volunteers or spectators.

Coach from the sidelines or undermine coaching decisions.

Engage in bullying, discriminatory behaviour or harassment. Attend club activities under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Smoke or vape in designated junior activity areas or while supervising children at club activities.

Use social media to bring the club, the game or any participant into disrepute.

There may be times when players or their parents/carers need to contact the club. In addition to the Coach each squad also has a Team manager. The Team Manager ensures the smooth running of each squad by handling organisation, communication and welfare responsibilities. This allows coaches to focus fully on player development and match performance.

REMEMBER THE 48 HOUR RULE!

TEAM MANAGERS SHOULD BE THE FIRST POINT OF CONTACT

Availability, lateness or absence
Injury or illness updates

Travel, kit, fixtures, timings\administrative queries

Welfare concerns needing escalation

Communication issues or uncertainty about processes

FOR PLAYERS & PARENTS

Notify the Team Manager of absence or lateness as early as possible

Use the agreed communication channel (e.g. Spond or email)

Keep messages respectful, concise and appropriate for youth safeguarding

Contact the coach only for coaching related matters
